Best comedic entertainment at Resorts World Genting

Laugh Die You features top Malaysian and Singaporean comedians

Genting Highlands, 2 February 2017 – Laughter is the best medicine—and to enjoy a hearty laugh, be there when the trio of Kuah Jenhan, Mark Lee and Jonathan Atherton deliver rib-tickling entertainment in their 150-minute show at Resorts World Genting.

“Laugh Die You” is the title of the comedy show to be held at the Genting International Showroom on 11 February 2017, 7.30pm. Brought to you by Popcorn Studio, the fifth installment of this show brings together three big names in stand-up comedy from both sides of the Causeway.

Jenhan is recognised as one of the best comedians in Malaysia while Atherton, based in Singapore, helms Comedy Club Asia. Lee, for his part, was the All-time Favourite Artiste in the Star Awards 2010—the first comedian to ever win the award.

Together, the trio intends to bring the house down when they “take the rivalry between Malaysians and Singaporeans to new highs—or lows,” delivering “plenty of Malaysian and Singaporean jokes.”

Will they succeed in tickling you pink? Well, their credentials should speak for themselves. Apart from Comedy Club Asia, Atherton—who calls Singapore home—is credited by many as having shaped the stand-up comedy circuit in Singapore.

Jenhan has also successfully carved out a career as a comedian and has contributed much to the field. In 2009, he set up the Malaysian Association of Chinese Comedians (MACC) along with Phoon Chi Ho and Douglas Lim. He held the Best of Malaysian Comedy in Australia in 2015, and was nominated for Perth Fringe World Comedy Award for his role in ‘Like This Like Dad’, 2016.

Lee's passion for humour is reflected in the various roles he has played, most notably playing the title role of Lee Tok Kong in Singapore's Media Corp Channel 5 series, ‘Police & Thief’. He has also appeared in movies—‘Money No Enough’ and ‘Liang Po Po’—and other TV shows like ‘Phua Chu Kang’ and ‘Holland V vs Su Hao’. He made his directorial debut in the comedy horror, ‘The Ghosts Must Be Crazy’.

Fans of the charismatic Leaner, who is fast becoming a sought-after figure, would recognise him as the frontman and lead vocalist of the Kuala Lumpur-based alternative rock band, The Marquee. But those who turn up at Laugh Die You will no doubt also appreciate how in touch he is with his emotions.

Leaner's signature style is his emotional and soulful delivery of songs, which covers various genres including pop, R&B and jazz. The singer says he loves “melancholic tunes and songs that people can relate to.”

This ambitious young man who has performed at various prestigious events, such as the wedding anniversary event of Tun Dr. Mahathir and his wife, is a multi tasker—he is also involved in artiste management. And next year, he will release his debut album which would undoubtedly win him even more recognition.
