Hong Kong Cantopop diva Frances Yip returns to Resorts World Genting for a very special concert **Celebrating 70 years of the legendary singer and her enduring songs**

Genting Highlands, 13 March 2018 – The voice of a generation, legendary Cantopop singer Frances Yip once again takes the stage at the Arena of Stars, Resorts World Genting to celebrate her 70 years of life and music with adoring fans in the Happy 70th Frances Live in Genting concert. Taking place on June 16, 2018, the one-night-only concert will see the diva belt through her long list of enduring hits, many of which became the soundtrack for Hong Kong and Asian listeners over the 1980s and 1990s.

Now based in Sydney, Australia, Yip is a familiar face at Resorts World Genting, she has graced the mountaintop with her powerful vocals over the years. Discovered at the Sharp's Night Four Lights Competition on Hong Kong television in 1969, she began her singing career singing commercial jingles and recorded her first album – Love Without End in the same year.

Named Ambassador of Hong Kong for Cathay Pacific and the Hong Kong Tourism Board in 1973, she was then signed by EMI records and went on to record over 80 albums in her career in a variety of languages, including Cantonese, Mandarin, English, Japanese, Malay and Thai. At the Hong Kong sovereignty transfer ceremony in 1997, she was the face of the nation, serving as co-presenter. She is best known for performing theme songs for famous TVB television drama series in the 1980s and early 1990s, including her signature tune – The Bund, the theme of the celebrated TVB series of old Shanghai gangsters starring Chow Yun-Fat.

Fans can expect to hear The Bund at the concert, along with other songs such as Wishes from The Bund II, and covers of songs such as You Don't Have To Say You Love Me and Besame Mucho that defined her early career.

The Happy 70th Frances Live in Genting concert will take place at 8.30pm on June 16, 2018 at the Arena of Stars, Resorts World Genting. Concert tickets are priced at RM88 (PS4), RM128 (PS3), RM168 (PS2), RM218 (PS1), RM268 (VIP) and RM328 (VVIP). An additional RM4 processing fee applies. Genting Rewards Card (GRC) members enjoy a 10%

discount when they purchase via Genting Point Redemption or with cash or credit card. This is applicable for all price scales. Tickets for children are priced at RM50.
